- 1 Sterling Memorial Library – 120 High Street
- 2 Yale Memorial Carillon tours – Harkness Tower (meet at the Branford gate across from JE closest to High Street on Memorial Walkway)
- 3 Yale Visitors Center – 149 Elm Street
- 4 Yale Art Gallery (various tours of collections or exhibits) – 1111 Chapel Street
- 5 Yale Peabody Museum (tours of Collections and Exhibits) – 170 Whitney Ave
- 6 Yale Sacred Sites Tour (walking tour begins at Battell Chapel) – Corner of College & Elm Streets
- 7 Hillhouse Avenue National Historic District Walking Tour – Meet at Hillhouse Ave & Sachem St
- 8 School of Architecture Exhibit – 180 York Street, Rudolph Hall
- 9 Cushing/Whitney Medical Library – Sterling Hall of Medicine, 333 Cedar Street
- 10 Yale School of Drama/Repertory Theatre (walking tour begins at University Theatre) – 222 York
- 11 Tours of historic Grove Street Cemetery – 227 Grove Street (Meet just inside the gate at the Chapel/Cemetery Office)
- 12 West Campus Tours – Roundtrip transfers are every 20 minutes: from central campus the Green Shuttle departs from Lot 22 at Science Hill. From the Medical School the Purple Shuttle departs from 333 Cedar Street. If driving: enter at the visitor center at the western entrance off I-95 (exit 41, Marsh Hill Road). Take the first right turn and follow the signs to the barn.
